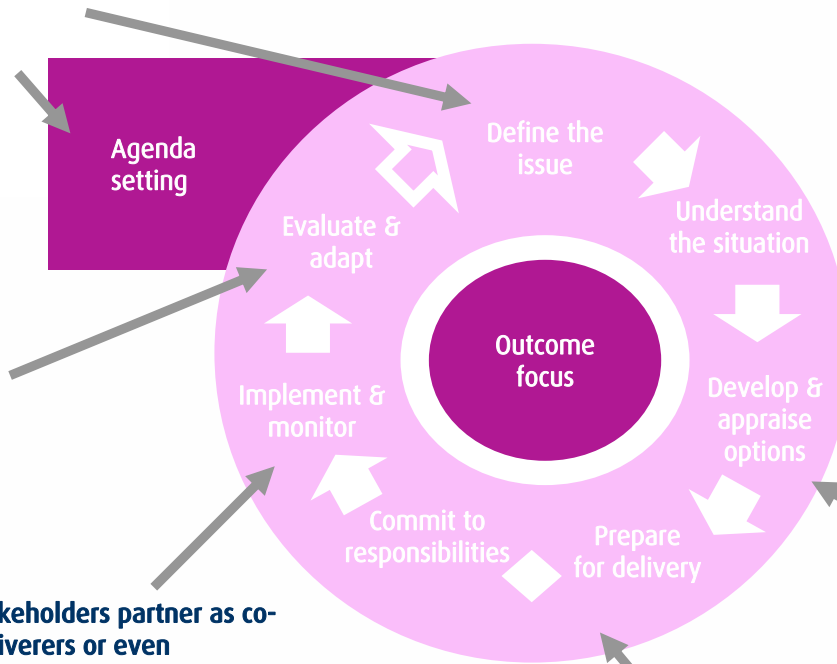


Engagement and the policy-making cycle

- Deliberative forums

- Focus groups
- Consensus conference
- Stakeholder dialogue
- Polling

Stakeholders provide citizen/user feedback to refine implementation:

- User panels
- Citizen panels
- Surveys (online/paper)
- Opinion polls

Stakeholders consulted on the detail of the proposals / commenting on drafts:

- Written consultations (e- and paper)
- Public debate (media publicity)

Stakeholders partner as co-deliverers or even empowered at local level:

- Deliberative forms
- Public meetings
- Participatory Appraisal
- Education & Training
- Advisory Committees
